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
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

### Hindi Diwas Celebration (14th September 2022)



### Non-Violence Day (1st October, 2022)



### Cyber Awareness Day (6th October, 2022)









### National Unity Day (31st October,2022)


### National Constitution Day (26th Nov, 2022)











### International Women day (7th March, 2023)






Shaheed Bhagat Singh Martyrdom Day (24th March, 2023)

On the first day of the NSS camp organized by GHG Harprakash College for Women, Sidhwan, on the theme 'Swachh Bharat Abhiyan'






### Forth Day (28th March,2023)




