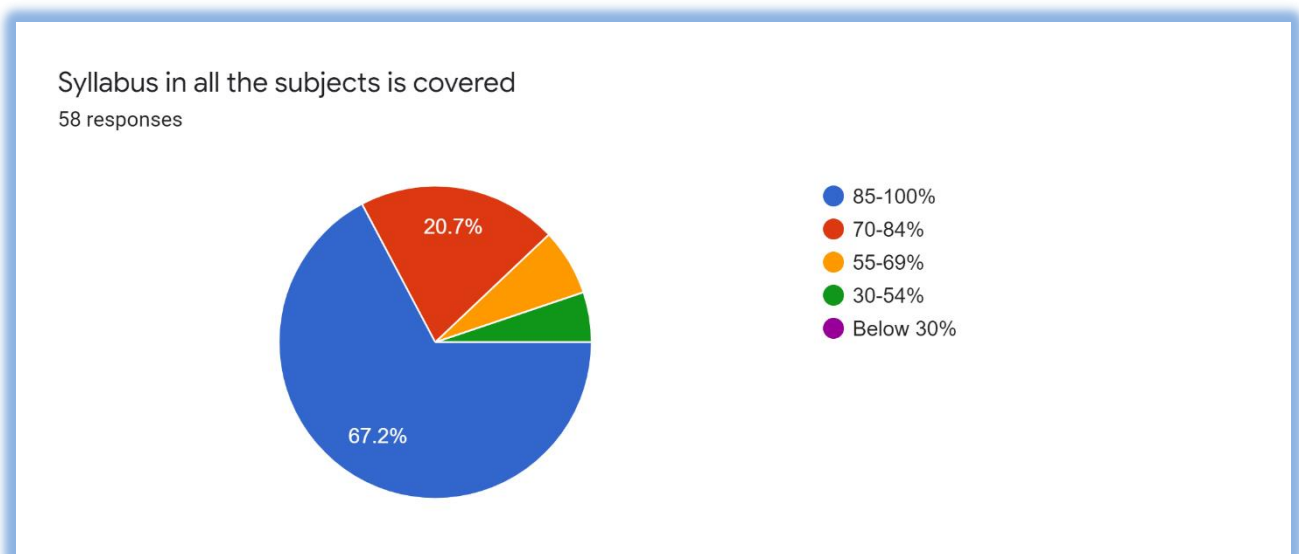
Survey Process

Survey Sample

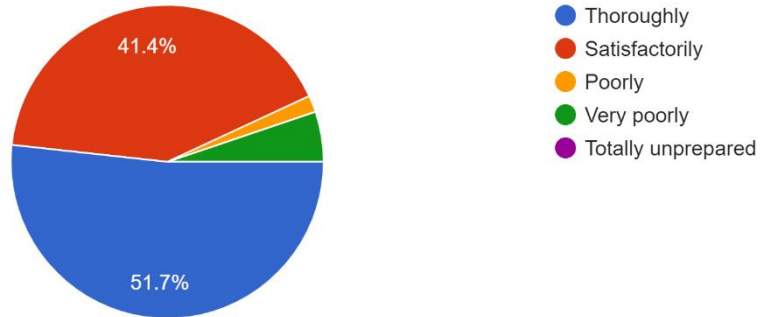

Survey Results: The results are being presented in the form of self-explanatory pie charts as follows:



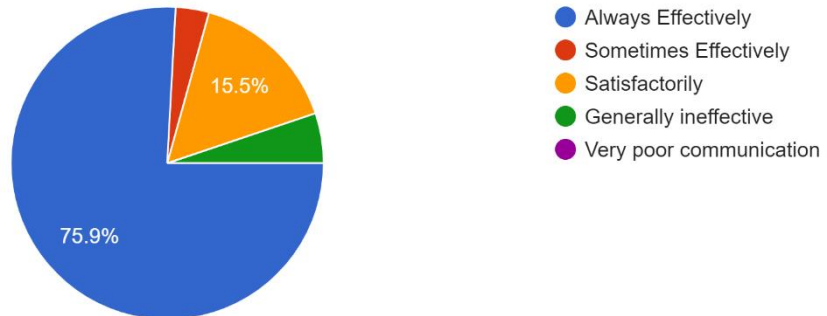
Teachers prepare for the classes

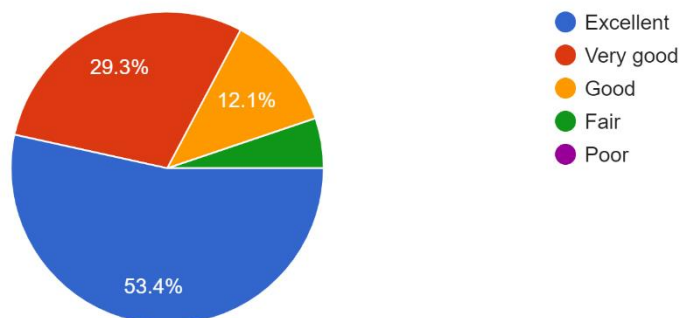
Teachers communicate during teaching

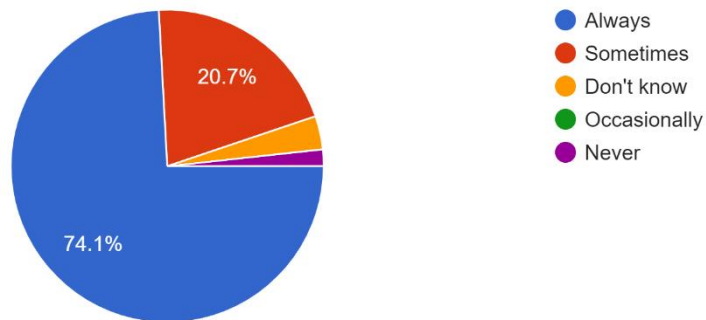
Teacher's approach to teaching is

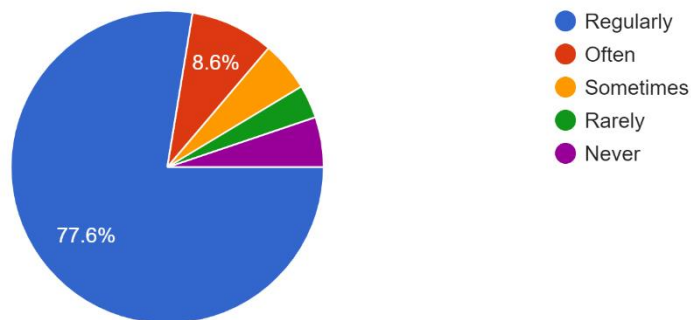
Performance in assignments/tests is discussed

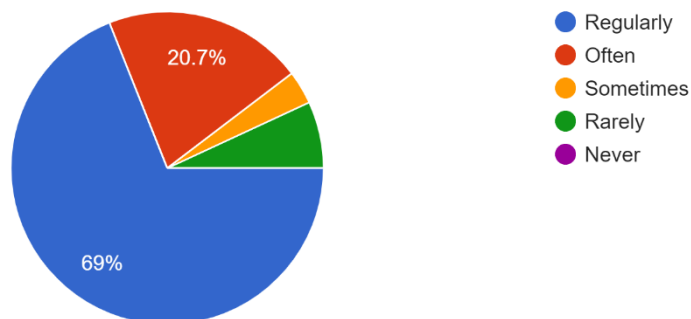
Internship, student exchange, and field activities are promoted in the institute

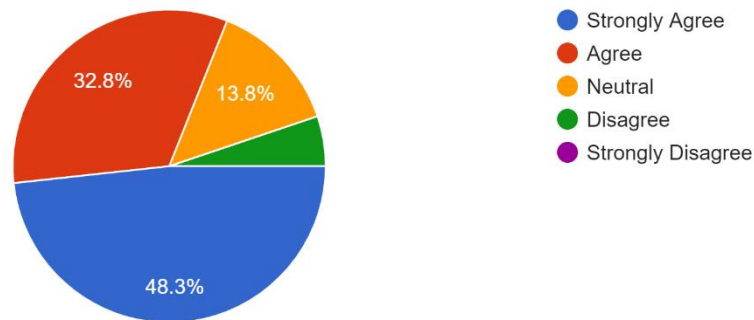
Cognitive, Affective and Conative development is facilitated through various co-curricular activities organised in the institute.

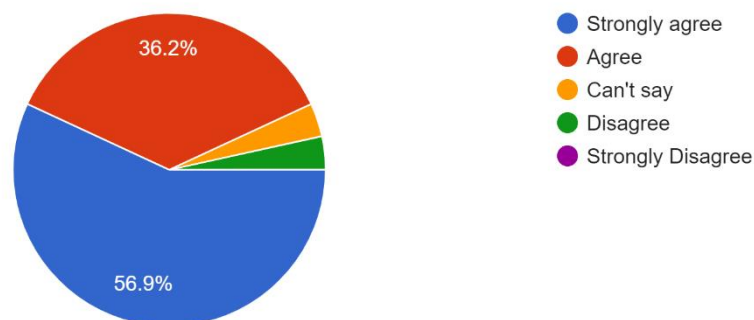
Internal evaluation process is fair
