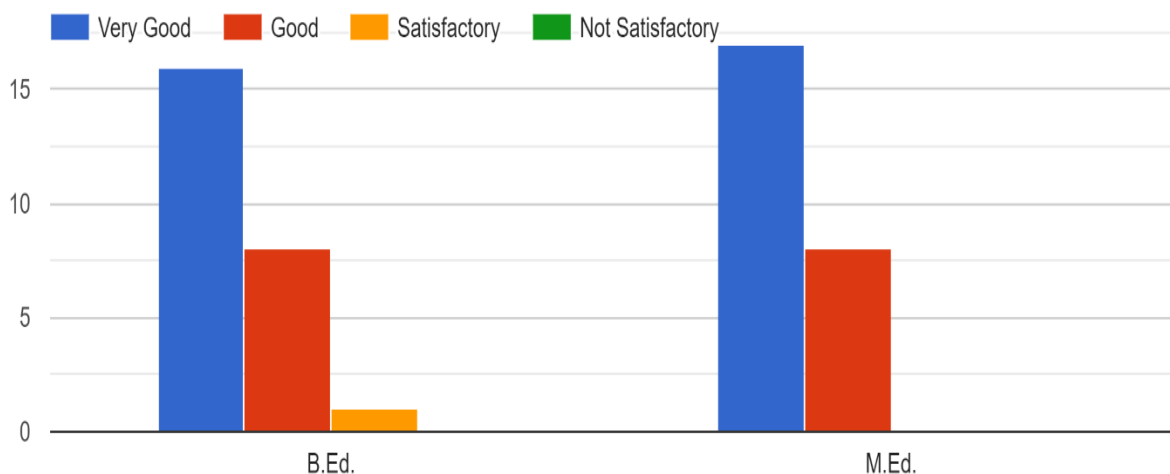


# Empolyer Feeddback Analysis on Curriculum 2021-22

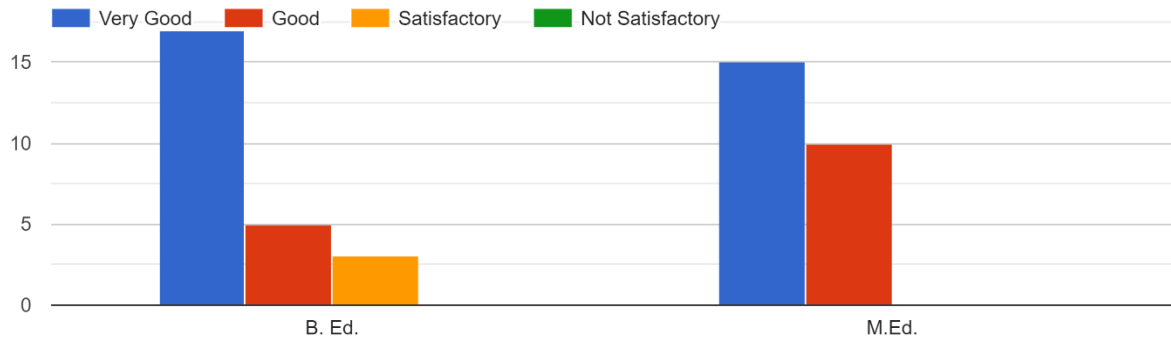
## Data Collection and Analysis

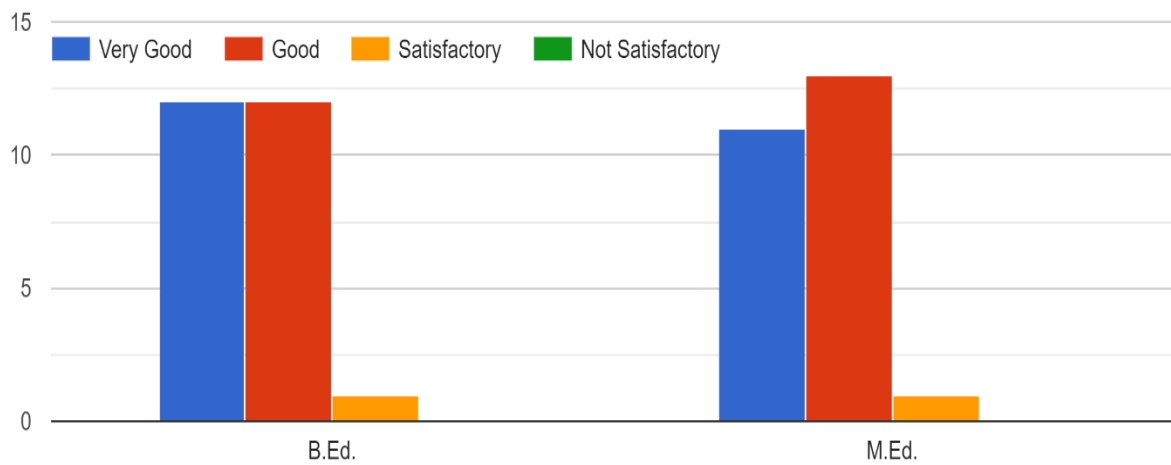
### 1. Curriculum for the development of Teaching Skills



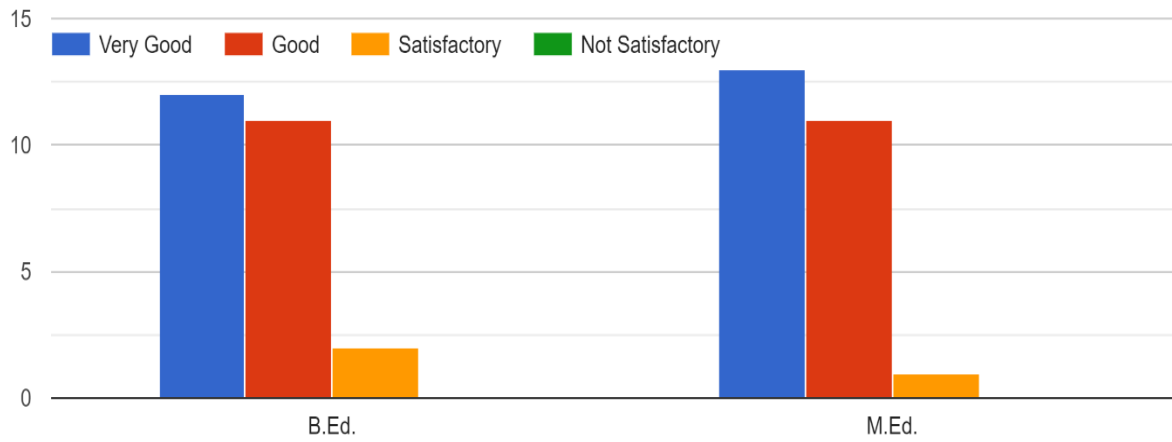

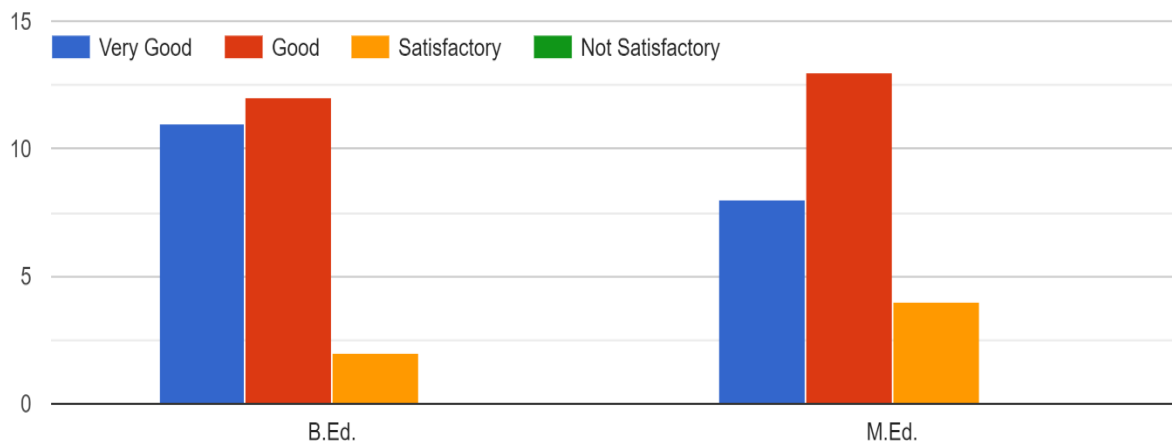
## 3. Course as per needs of School



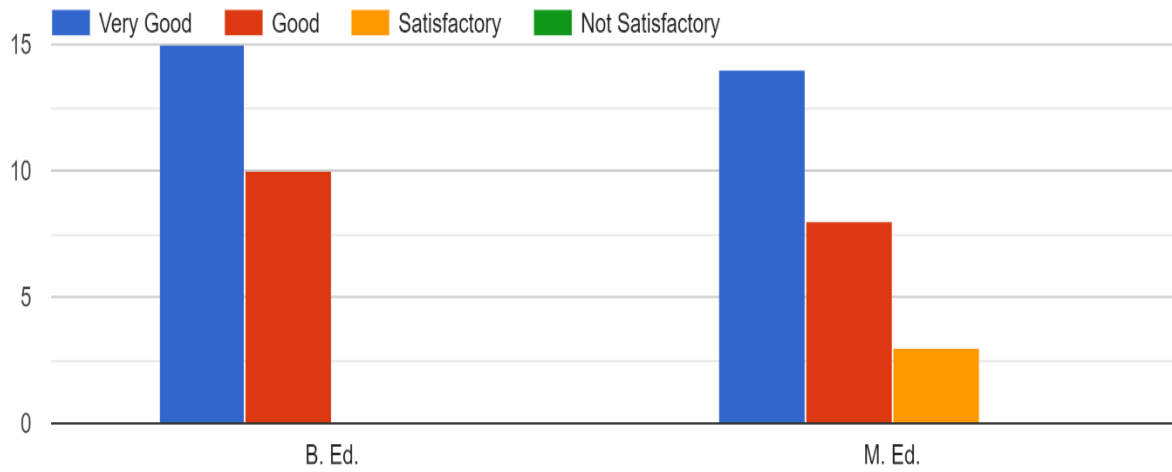

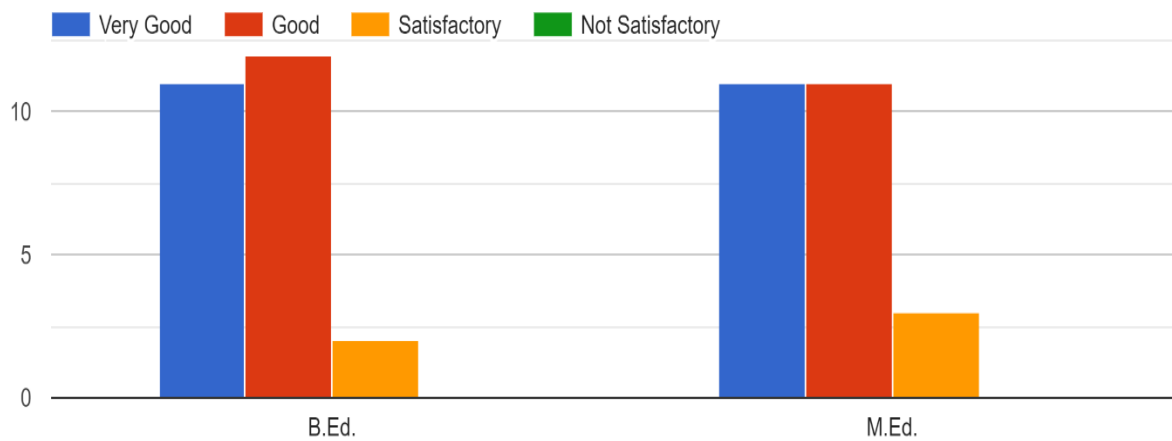

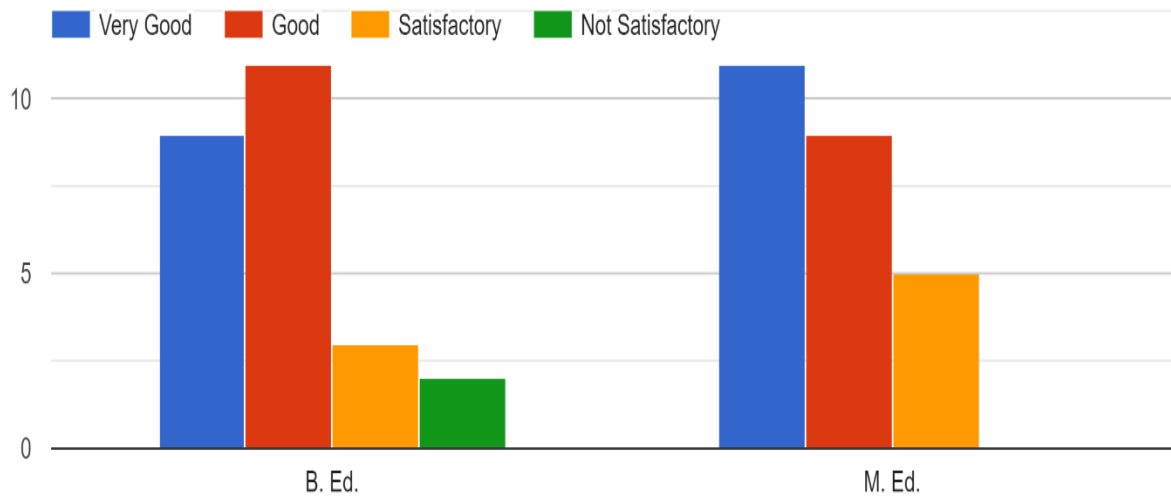

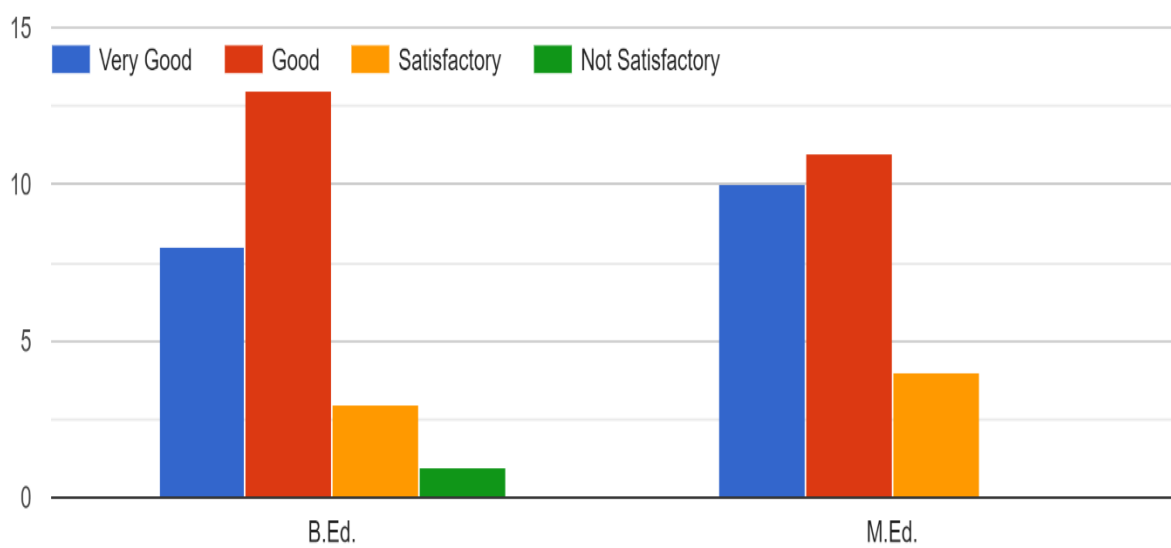
