

Chart-3 Curriculum content was interesting








Chart-5 depicts 56.3%students were strongly agree, 40.6%students were agree and 3.1% were undecided regarding the development of personality in the students through curriculum










Chart-9 depicts 34.4% students were strongly agree, 56.3%students were agree and 9.4% were undecided regarding the adequacy of the ICT facility.





CHART-14 Good Expression/Communication Skills












Chart-18 depicts 40.6% students were strongly agree, 50% agree but 9.4% students were undecided regarding pupils participation in the class through questioning









