1. STUDENT PROFILE:



2. **STUDENT FEEDBACK ON** (CURRICULUM PLANNING, IMPLEMENTATION & EVALUATION)




Chart-2 depicts 45.6% students were strongly agree, 52.6% students were agree but only 1.8% were undecided about the adequacy of the curriculum.




Chart-3 depicts 47.4% students were strongly agree, 50.9% students were agree but only 1.8% were disagree about the students interest in the curriculum

CHART 4: Curriculum fullfiling your expectation



CHART 5: Curriculum helping in developing your personality



CHART 6: Curriculum is relevant for the solution of problems faced by students



CHART 7: Curriculum helped in developing your teaching skills





CHART 9: ICT facilities were adequate



CHART 10: Variety of Co-Curricular activities were conducted in the college]




Chart-10 depicts 61.4% students were strongly agree, 38.6% students were agree regarding the conduct of the co-curricular activities in the college.

CHART 11: Regular class and semester wise house test conducted in the college



CHART 12 :Feedback was given for continous improvement]




Chart-12 depicts 56.1% students were strongly agree, 42.1% students were agree but only 1.8% were disagree regarding the feedback given for continuous improvement.




Chart-13 depicts 31 students were strongly agree, 25 of them agree but only 1 student undecided about the subject knowledge of the teacher.




Chart-14 depicts 31 students were strongly agree, 25 of them agree but 1 students undecided regarding the good expression & communication skills of teacher.




Chart-15 depicts 32 students were strongly agree, 23 of them agree but 1 students undecided regarding the punctuality of the teachers.



Chart-16 depicts 32 students were strongly agree, 23 of them agree but 1 students undecided regarding the behaviour of the teachers.





Chart-17 depicts 32 students were strongly agree, 23 of them agree but 1 students was undecided regarding the ability of the teachers to integrate course material with current issue.


CHART 18: Questioning/Encouraging students participation

Chart-18 depicts 30 students were strongly agree, 26 of them agree but 1 students was undecided regarding pupils participation in the class through questioning


CHART 19: Help provided by teacher in and out of the

Chart-19 depicts 33 students were strongly agree, 23 of them agree but 1 students was undecided regarding the help provided by the teachers in and outside the class.


CHART 20: Ability to organise ppt presentation/e content/ video lectures/assignments

CHART 22: Sufficient feedback by the teacher




Chart- 28 students were strongly agree and 26 of them agree and 1 student undecided about sufficient feedback given by the teachers

CHART 23: Ability to maintain discipline




Chart-23 depicts 28 students were strongly agree and 26 of them agree and 1 student undecided about the ability of the teachers to maintain discipline.

Major recommendation

- 1. Maximum students were satisfied from the Curriculum part, as individual difference are always there, so it was recommended that the curriculum should be as per the expectation of all the students.
- 2. It was noticed that only few of the students disagree regarding the availability of the reference books in library, it was recommended that more reference books should be purchased.
- 3. It was found that only few of the students disagree from the availability of the ICT facilities in the college, it was recommended to the college to fulfill the needs of the students.
- 4. It was observed by the students that teachers communication skill, punctuality, behavior, discipline, skill of delivering the subject matter through the use of IT, skill of encouraging students to ask questions and skill of integrating content with current issue was excellent, so it was recommended to the teachers that they should continue with these abilities, skills and habits.
