Academic Achievements

GHG Harparkash College of Education for Women, SidhwanKhurd is a Grant-in-Aid Scheme of Govt. Aided College affiliated to Panjab University, Chandigarh. The College is covered under 2F 12B of UGC and is recognized by NCTE, New Delhi.

It is a pioneer Institution located in the natural surroundings and healthy environment. The institution was established in the year 1955 and is rendering service to the Women Community in the field of Teacher Education. It offers M.Ed, B.Ed and PG Diploma in Guidance & Counselling and is approved Research Centre for Ph.D Course Work in the field of Education.

During the Session 2022-23, following no. of students were enrolled in the courses B.Ed-I- 37 students, B.Ed-II-37 students, M.Ed-I -5 students, M.Ed-II -4 students PGDGC- 13students. All students got excellent results and the pass percentage was 100%.

Infrastructure Facilities

All the classrooms are ICT enabled. Various Labs like Psychology Lab, Home Science Lab, Maths Lab, Social Studies Lab Science Lab, ICT Resource Centre Lab and Language Lab are well equipped. The library of the College is rich and automated and holds special collection in the multidisciplinary field of Education. It subscribes to E-resources and is member of INFLIBNET N-LIST Program. It provides support facilities like internet surfing and reprographic services to its readers. College has well equipped Gym. There is hostel facility for staff and students. Multipurpose seminar hall, Language Lab, auditorium, departmental store, play fields, stadium, Gurudwara Sahib and canteen are some of the resources which are shared under the same Management of Sidhwan Institutions. There is also Charitable Hospital and Ambulance service which is available for the students and

community. Sports Stadium has been designed for a better look and the upkeep of play fields is done on regular basis. 50KWpOnc Grid Solar Panels by TATA and 10KWp On Grid Solar Panels by Luminous were installed in the college premises to make the campus eco friendly.

IQAC

The College has active IQAC. Composition of IQAC is in compliance with NAAC. During the Session, three meetings were held with different important agendas. After discussions, action plans were prepared and further actions were taken accordingly.

IQAC meetings were held on 29th November 2022, 9th March, 2023 and 15th May, 2023.

Code of Conduct

The College is well known for its discipline. The written document of Code of Conduct was developed during this year. Academic and Administrative Audit

IQAC conducts Academic Audit and Administrative Audit and monitor the activities of college. Under Academic audit, students' admission, student induction program, teaching learning (online or offline), organizing activities and competitions for students in different fields, organizing Capacity Building Program/ webinars for students, faculty and non-teaching staff, linkages with other Institutions, Value Added Courses, Examinations, Remedial Teaching, results, Research activities, Faculty Development programme and feedbacks are checked. Administrative audit includes ensuring decentralization to care committees, ensuring facilities to staff, welfare measures for staff and placement efforts are done.

Research Initiatives

Research Policy which was amended on 16th Jan, 2021 is being implemented in new form since then various provisions like provision of duty leave, award of appreciation and financial assistance to faculty for attending seminars, workshops were planned and amended accordingly.

College infrastructure is available to the teachers and students who are doing research work. Rich automated library, Psychology lab, ICT facilities like ICT Research Centres and Wi-fi facilities are available to the Researchers. The Researchers were also given support in the form of seed money, student leave for field work and through interactive sessions conducted on research from time to time.

Green Initiatives

The College has its Energy Policy which motivates the students and staff for energy management by saving energy. Other Policy initiatives includes Green Policy/ initiatives and Solid Waste Management by segregation of waste and using biodegradable waste for making manure via-vermi compost method. The liquid waste is also managed in eco-friendly way.

College is maintaining lush green lawns. It has fruit plants, medicinal plants and large number of ornamental plants which adds to the beauty of the College by giving clean and fresh look.

Rain Water Harvesting measures are in place in the Campus for managing rain water.

29 saplings were planted in the college premises by students which are being looked after by them.

Herbal Garden was established by the Eco Club and many herbal plants like Hibiscus, Tejpatta,Nirgundi, Hing, Tulsi, Cinnamon, Gurmar, Ashwagandha,Hing, Murraya, Insulin, All spice, Stevia, Bhringraj, Aloe Vera, Sanay and Moringa were planted in the garden to make aware students and staff and community about the benefits associated with the herbs.

College participated in the Annual Flower Show held at PAU, Ludhiana on 2nd March 2023 to 3rd March, 2023. College also participated in Flower Show and on the sport photography competition held at Gurudwara Sri Guru Singh Sabha, Sarabha Nagar, Ludhiana, Altogether 23 prizes were won by the college in these competitions.

Extension Lecturer was organized by Eco-Club. S. Manpreet Singh Grewal, President, National Farmer Association delivered a lecture on the theme 'Sustainable and Organic Farming' on 22nd December, 2022.

Solar Panels

50KWp On GridSolar Panels by TATA,and 10KWp Off GridSolar Panels by Luminous were installed in the college premises to use unconventional source of energy. The work of installation was completed on 13th May 2022.

Internship Programs

B.Ed students of Sem-I, II and III undergo pre-internship and 6 months internship programs respectively. Third semester is devoted to six months Internship Program. Before going to Internship, student's orientation workshop of two weekswas organized to acquaint themwith different types of lesson planning, use of instructional media, library resources and usage, online and offline teaching, conducting test, organizing co-curricular activities, mentoring the students, counselling and demo lessons etc.. The students were also oriented about administrative tasks like organizing PTMs, preparing records and registers, managing mid day meals etc.

After completion of their Internship, discussion lessons are planned where students teach in front of college teachers and their peer group in their respective subjects. The final lessons in pedagogies are also held as per the dates allotted by the university. The observer from the outside and external examiners are deputed for the smooth conduct of final practical session.

Value Added Courses

College offered Value Added Courses on Self Management, OER, ICT Tools in Teaching and Career Counselling Skills from 16th December 2022 to 30th December, 2022 and on 'Digital Literacy & Communications Skills' from 14th March, 2023 to 25th March, 2023. Students were made aware about the ICT tools, listening skills, importance of effective communication skills and were given exposures in the Language Lab. They were also taught about MS Office, formatting techniques, superscripts and other shortcut keys.

A questionnaire was prepared to get feedback from students about teachers, their teaching skills, efficiency, behavior &communication skills for the overall improvement of the systems.

Feedback was also taken from students, employers and alumni about the curriculum working of internees and about overall experiences respectively. Feedbacks were analyzed, report was prepared. The feedbacks are being uploaded every year on the college website as well as in AQAR reports.

Remedial Teaching:

- After receiving students achievement in House Test, students were divided into two groups. One group of high achiever named as booster group and the second one of low achievers named as potential group. The remedial teaching was organized where potential group was helped to understand the course content in easy way and booster group was provided with extra reference material.
- Audio lectures were recorded for blind student.
- Resource Room is established for differently abled students with facilities like wheel chair, bed, computer system with speakers, table and chair.

Placement Cell supports the students for their placements in different schools after completion of their studies.

Guidance & Counselling Cell provides counseling services to students.

Grievances Redressal Cell listens and receives students complaints and readdress them within seven days.

Anti-Ragging Cell keeps a vigil on ragging activities and discourages the same. The students are also members of different committees of the college so as to inculcate leadership qualities among them and also to bring them in the mainstream of the organization.

Learning Management System

LMS is specially designed for College to facilitate the teaching learning process. It serves the purpose of assignment submission, online assessment test, attendance, sharing study method, feedback, chat between teacher and students. Teachers can also develop their own MOOC on this platform. The data is retrieved after a year. This is an excellent ICT platform for student teacher interaction. It served as medium for online classes during Covid-Pandamic.

E-content Recording Room

The College has the facility of recording the lessons of teacher as E-content for students. A room is especially devoted with modern facilities like computer system with speakers, LCD Projectors and screen as tele-prompters and Green Chroma as background. LCD light and tripod stand is used for fixing the camera and software for editing the lessons.

Teaching and Learning

In M.Ed, B.Ed and PG Diploma in Guidance & Counselling and Ph.D Course Work, ICT is extensively used in teaching students through offline or blended mode. Internet speed was upgraded to 300mbps. College Campus is wi-fi. New projectors were purchased and all classrooms are ICT enabled.
