
International Women Day

students, 40 school students, 20 Teaching and 10 non-teaching staff, and 15 women from community participated in the seminar.






Book Exhibition 30th March, 2022

With this mind set a group of volunteers come forward and decided to devote their lives for the mission of saving abandoned children and this decision resulted in the establishment of SGB International foundation in 2003 with 3 abandoned children rescued from Railway Station Ludhiana. During these years number of orphan and abandoned children are admitted in this home. With untiring efforts of management and staff of SGB International Foundation all children are enjoying the real family experience that their pitiless parents chose to deprive them of simply because of pressure of society.

Coordinators of the ProgrammeDr Kiran Duggal and Dr. Shallyorganised a visit to orphan and abandoned children NGO"Baal Ghar, Dham Talwandi Khurd"working under the aegis of SGB International foundation on 7-4-2022. Principal Dr Amandeep Kaur along with five teachers and 36 students of B.Ed, M.Ed and PGDGC went personally to meet the tiny tots.

Students of the college visited family houses created for children by SGB foundation. Each family house has three bed rooms, a drawing cum dining room, a kitchen and toilet area besides a kitchen garden to grow vegetables. Presently, there are 50 Children living in five family houses. In all, there shall be place for more than 100 children in 8 family houses making it a mini village like community. Children residing in SGB Home are given all facilities to help them achieve their fullest potential in life.

Children live under the care of committed women, who have dedicated themselves to the cause of needy children. They are women with strong motherly instinct who create an alternate family with needy children. Children attend regular schools in the local vicinity. Adequate recreational and sports facilities are provided. The staff and students collected money voluntarily to donate the groceries also. Overall, the visit really sensitized the staff and students towardsorphan, abandoned and destitute children.





Donation Camp 13th April, 2022

Donation camp was organised by the GHG Harparkash College of education for Women Sidhwan Khurd, Ludhiana for poor residing in slum areas on 13.04.22. deaf children with the help of their teachers and also visited the various rooms, laboratories such as speech therapy lab, home science lab, computer lab and art and craft room to understand the way of teaching learning being carried in the school. The school imparts education from Nursery to 12th. There is a provision for hobby classes such as Home Science, Art & Craft and Computer. The school has two buses to transport to student from their place of residence to the school and back.
