DATA COLLECTION AND ANALYSIS



Findings

1.Syllabus coverage


The results indicate that 66.6% B.Ed. students agree that syllabus in all subjects is covered up to 85-100% and 28.6% M.Ed students agreed that up to 70-84% syllabus is covered at proper time.

Syllabus in all the subjects is covered 21 responses




2.Teachers Preparedness


3. Communication Skills


4. Teacher's approach to Teaching


5. Process of Internal Evaluation

52.4% students strongly agree and 33.3% agree that the process of Internal evaluation is fair.




6. Discussion on performance in assignments

90.5% students reported that college regularly promotes Internship, student exchange and field activities. Only 9.5% responded that such activities are often promoted in the college.




Internship, student exchange, and field activities are promoted in the institute 21 responses

8. Facilitation of Cognitive, affective and Conative development through various co-curricular activities



9. Learning Opportunities


66.7% students strongly agree that college provides opportunities to learn and grow and 33.3% students agree that this kind of opportunities are offered by the college.



10. Orientation about programme outcomes and course outcomes






12.Use of Illustrations

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
The Teacher illustrate the concepts with day to day life examples. 21 responses


The teachers identify strengths and weaknesses of students and provide right guidance to overcome weaknesses. 21 responses


Teachers use student centric methods such as experiential learning, participative and problem solving methodologies for providing rich learning experiences. 21 responses

Ample opportunities and encourgement is given to participate in co-curricular activities. 21 responses






16. Organisation of extension lectures/ Workshops


Institute organizes expert lectures, workshops or make other efforts to develop communication skills, life skills and employbility skills to make you ready for the world of work. 21 responses
