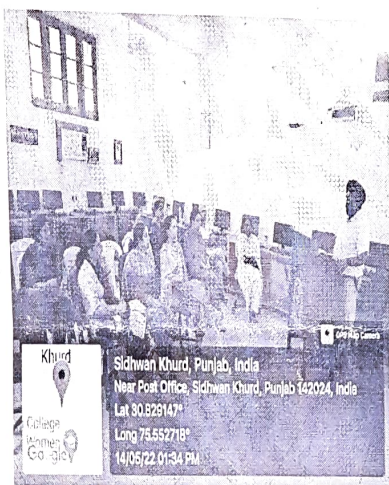
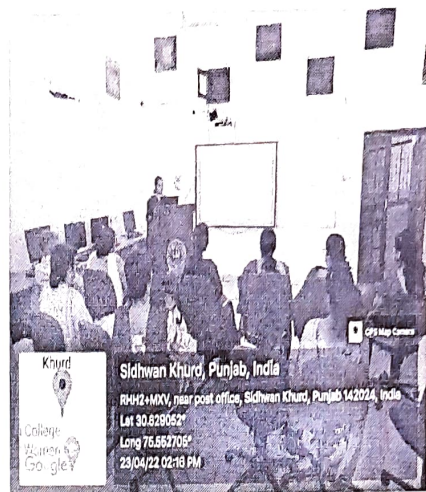
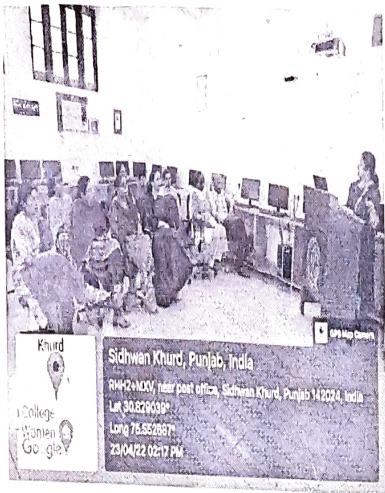

### Report of In-house Seminar's

2021-22

G.H.G. Harparkash College of Education organized two in house seminars on the draft given by UGC on NEP 2020. First in-house seminar was taken by Dr. Kiran Duggal, Associate Professor, on the theme 'Fostering Social Responsibility & Community Engagement in Higher Educational Institutions in India' on 23.04.22. She discussed its global context, community engagement in India and also various principles for community engagement. She elaborated operational guidelines, which included compulsory community engagement course, adapting existing courses for community engagement, offering new course and undertaking research in partnership etc. Doubts raised by faculty members were clarified in the session by the resource person.

Resource person in the second in- house seminar was Dr. Gurwinder Singh, Assistant Professor. The session was held on 14.05.22 and topic of seminar was 'Transforming Higher Education Institutions into Multidisciplinary Institutions'. He discussed in detail about approaches towards the setting up of multidisciplinary HEIs, requirements for a multidisciplinary HEI, general conditions, academic collaboration between institutions leading to multidisciplinary education and research, composition of the academic council, composition of the finance committee, merger of HEI, adding new departments, establishment of department of education in multidisciplinary institutions, constituent colleges of universities, multidisciplinary research in HEI Clusters, role of university and government , grievance redressal mechanism required for collaborating HEIs etc. The session was interactive and brought clarity to the various aspects related to transformation of higher education institutions into multidisciplinary institutions.
