Second Day (26th March,2023)



Forth Day (28th March,2023)


The fourth day of the NSS camp began with Prayer and Yoga session.




Fifth Day (29th March,2023)

Seventh Day (31th March,2023)




After the lecture volunteers participated in a yoga session.


Report of Personality Development Programme

On 8th May, 2023 students of B.Ed., M.Ed. and PG Diploma in Guidance and Counselling along with teachers Dr. Manjeet Kaur and Dr. Ajay Kumar visited Govt. Institute for Blind (Braille Bhawan), Jamalpur, Ludhiana as it is part of their curriculum. A total of 37 students from the college visited the school. The school was established in the year 1968 and is managed by Tribal and Social Welfare Department. The institute is affiliated to P.S.E.B., Mohali. The school consists of Grades from 1 to 10 and is Co-educational. The school has Government building. It has got 8 classrooms for instructional purposes. All the classrooms are in good condition. It has 2 other rooms for non-teaching activities. The school has a playground. The school has a library and has 200 books in its library. The school has qualified staff with having a special degree and training to teach students with visual impairments. The main objective of the school is to make the child an acceptable and a useful citizen of the society and also to make the society aware of their moral responsibility towards their children. Students of the college interacted with the students of the Braille Bhawan with the help of their teachers and also visited the various rooms, laboratories, Braille Press, Audio Recording, and Printing Press Section etc. to understand the way of teaching learning being carried in the school.







Hindi Diwas Celebration (14th September 2022)



Non-Violence Day (1st October, 2022)



Cyber Awareness Day (6th October, 2022)








National Unity Day (31st October,2022)


National Constitution Day (26th Nov, 2022)












International Women day (7th March, 2023)






Shaheed Bhagat Singh Martyrdom Day (24th March, 2023)

The following initiatives were undertaken by this Cell throughout the year to provide various Guidance and counselling services: -

- One day workshop on SWOT analysis was organised by Dr.Sarvjeet Kaur 13th March 2023 to make students competent in self-assessment skills.


- Our Alumna Ms. Vasudha has given Career talk on 21st July 2023 on capability building and skill enhancement initiatives in the area of career and personal counselling.






