

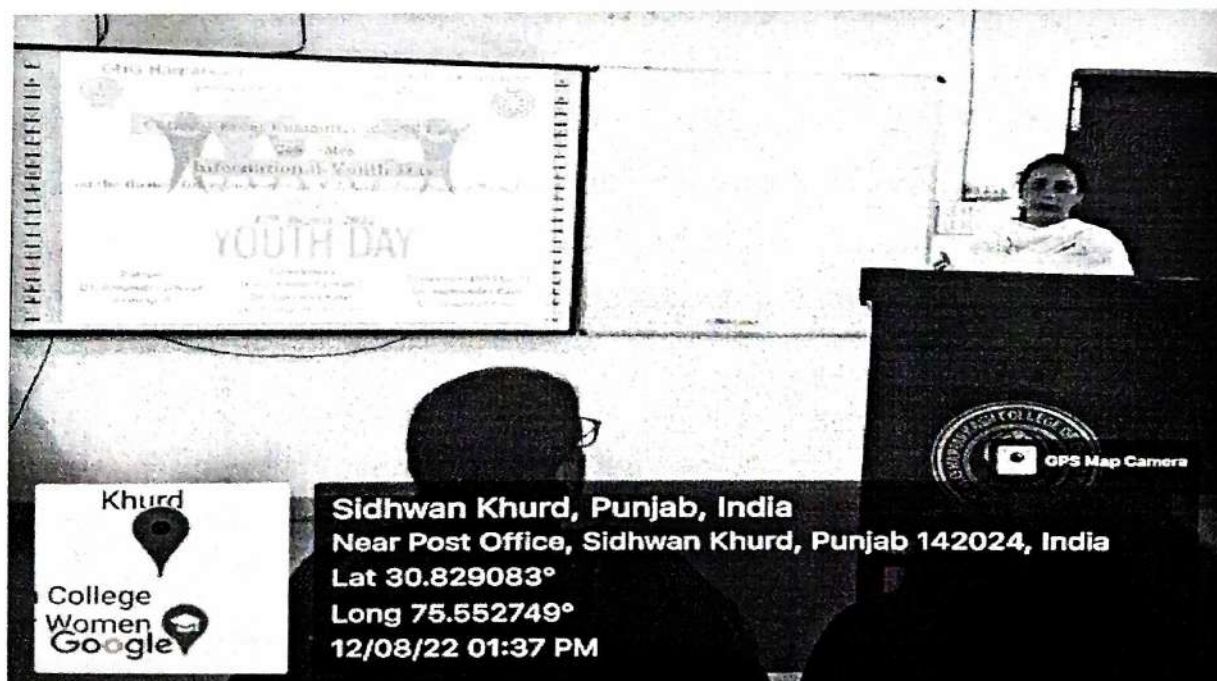

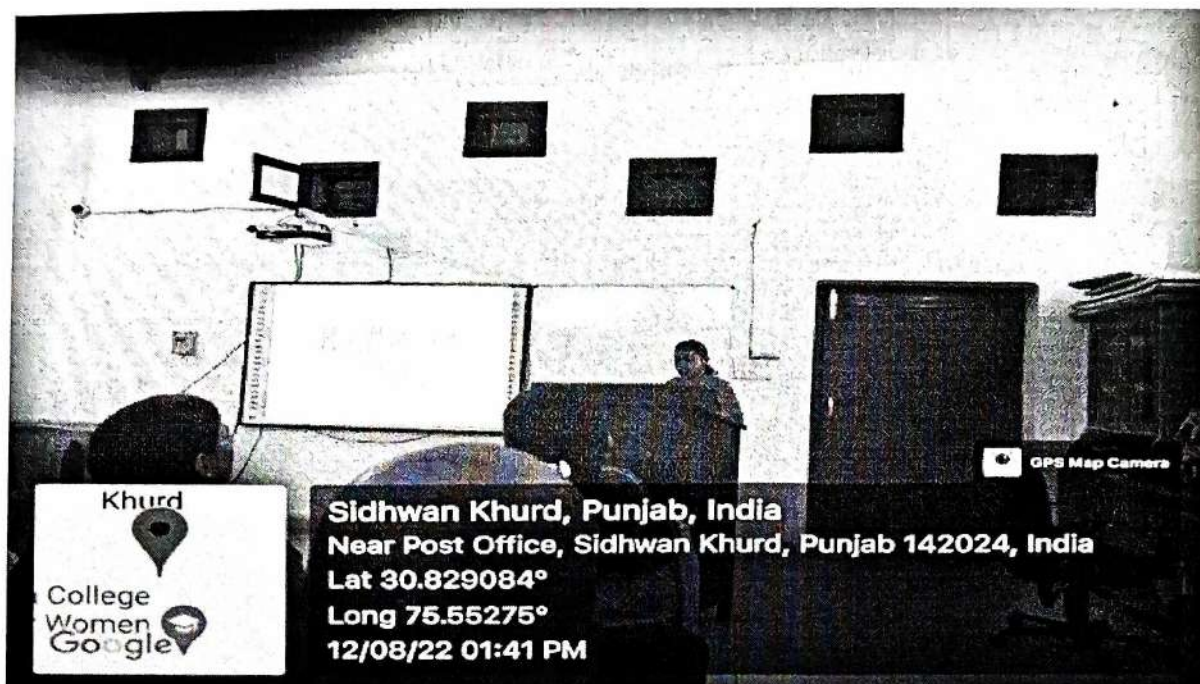

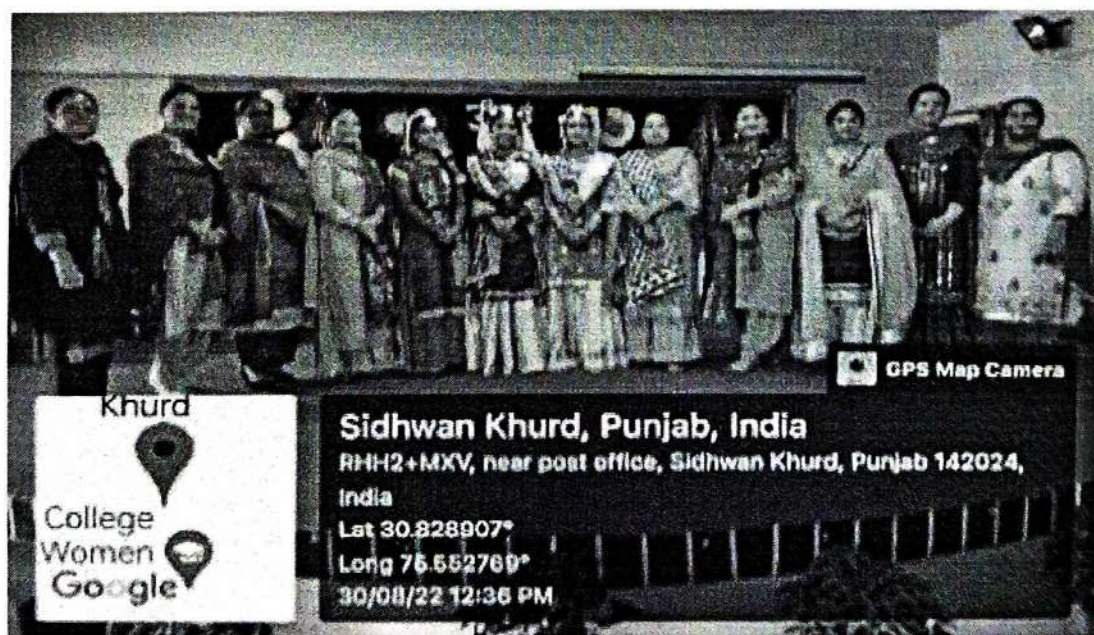

## Hindi Diwas Celebration (14th September 2022)

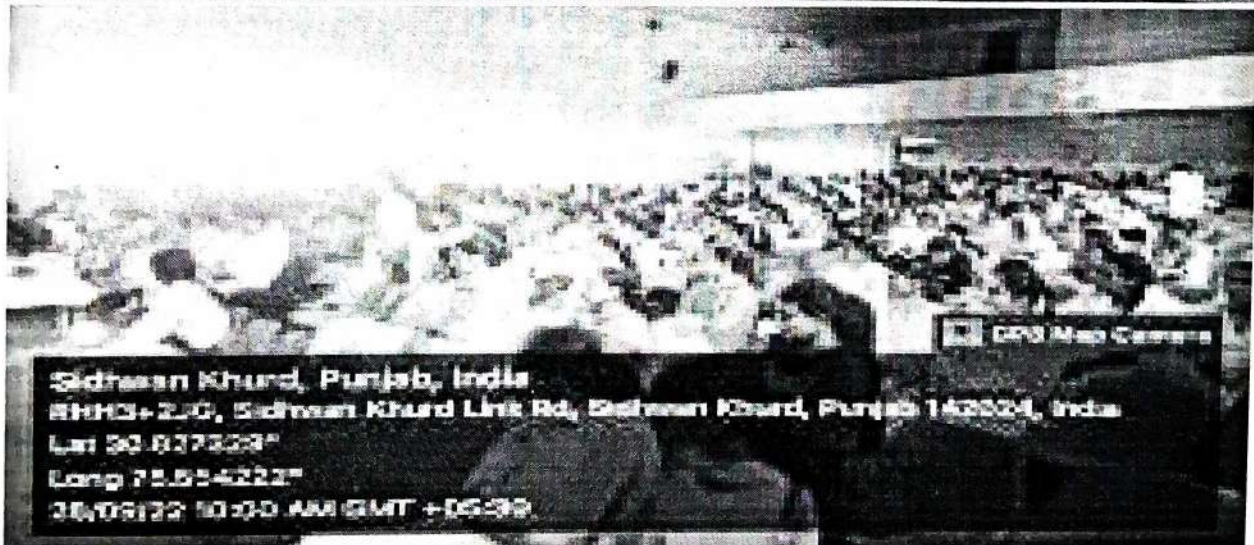

### **Non-Violence Day (1<sup>st</sup> October, 2022)**

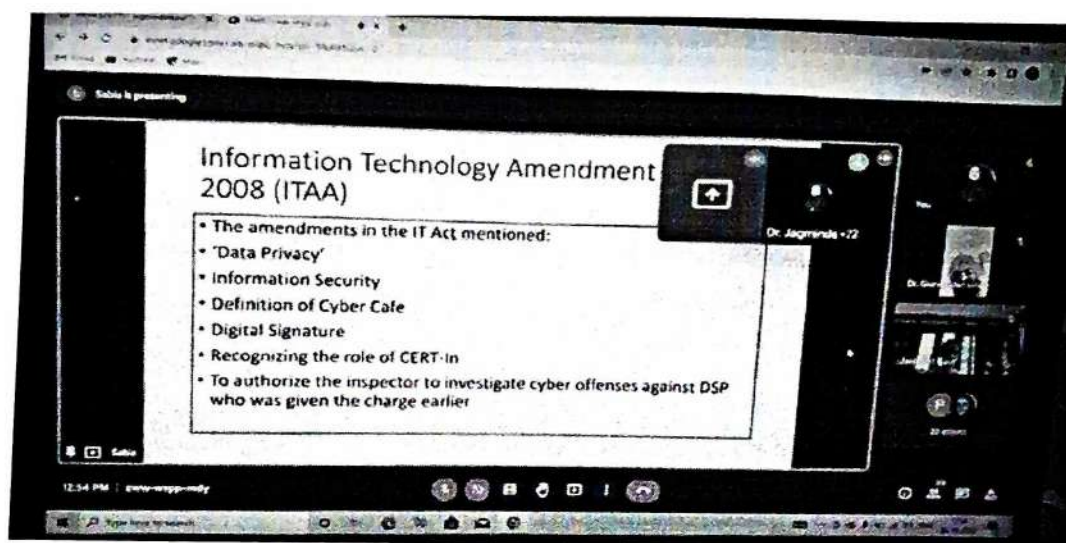

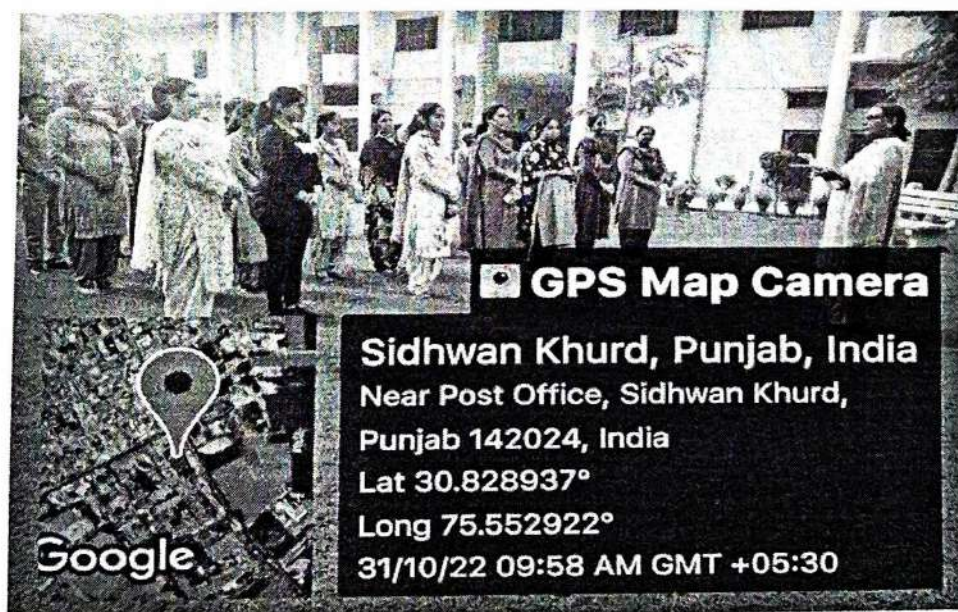
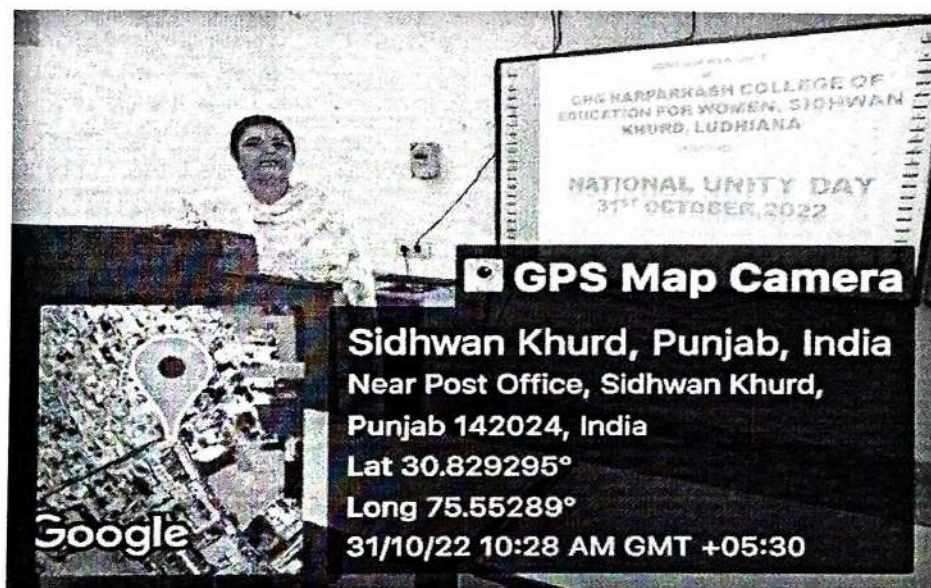
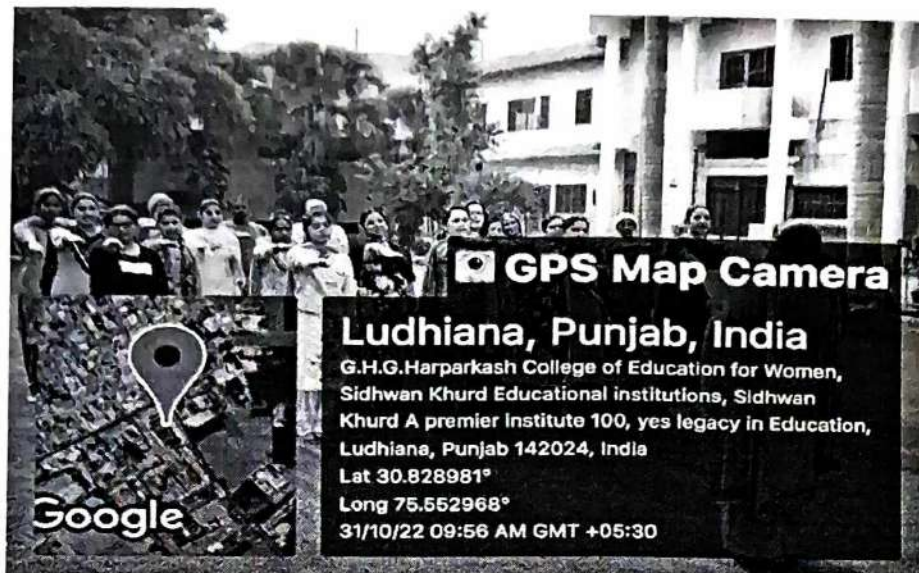




## National Unity Day (31<sup>st</sup> October, 2022)

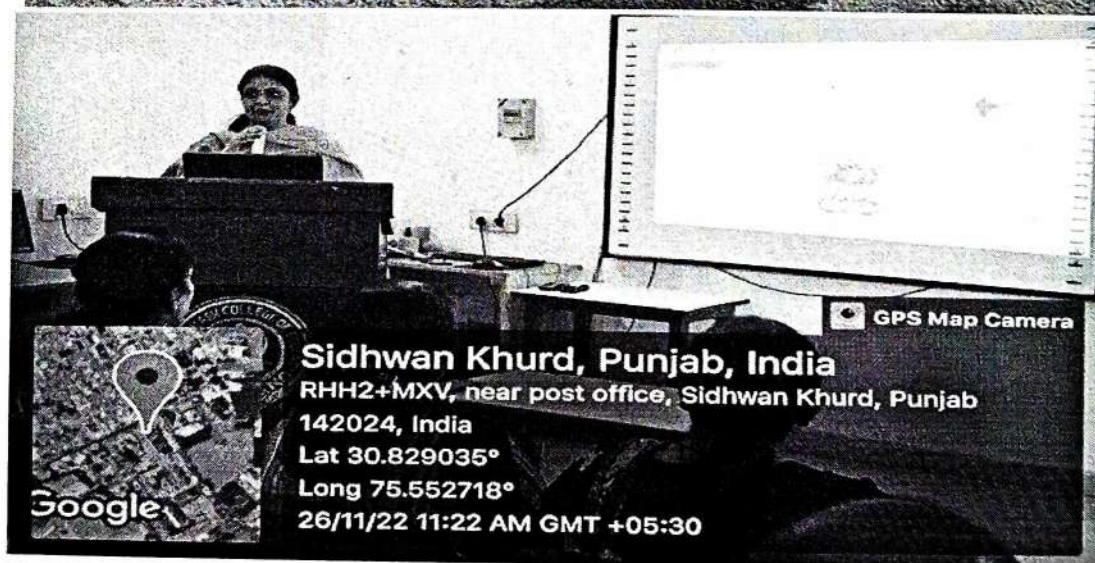
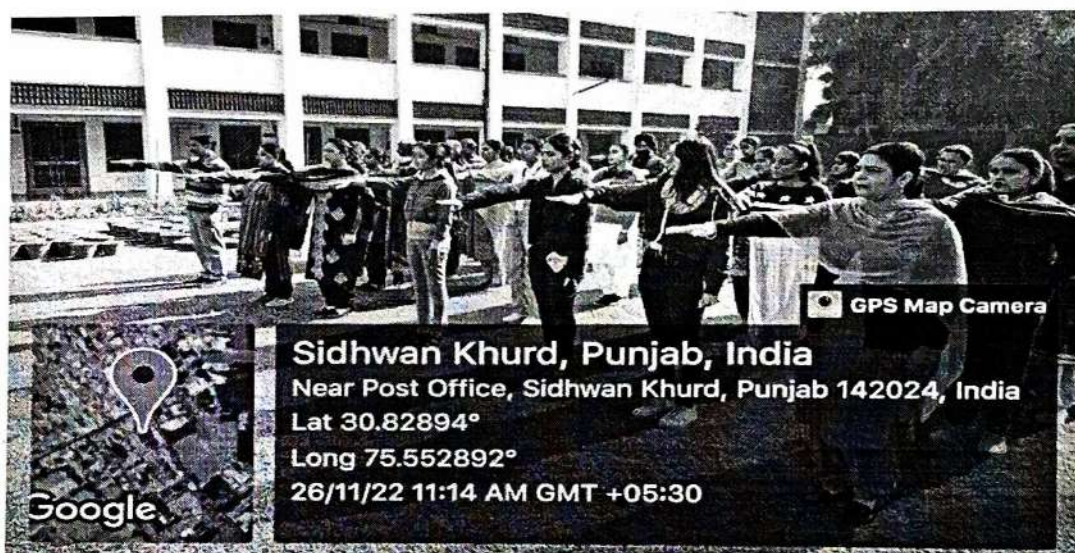






## National Constitution Day (26<sup>th</sup> Nov, 2022)

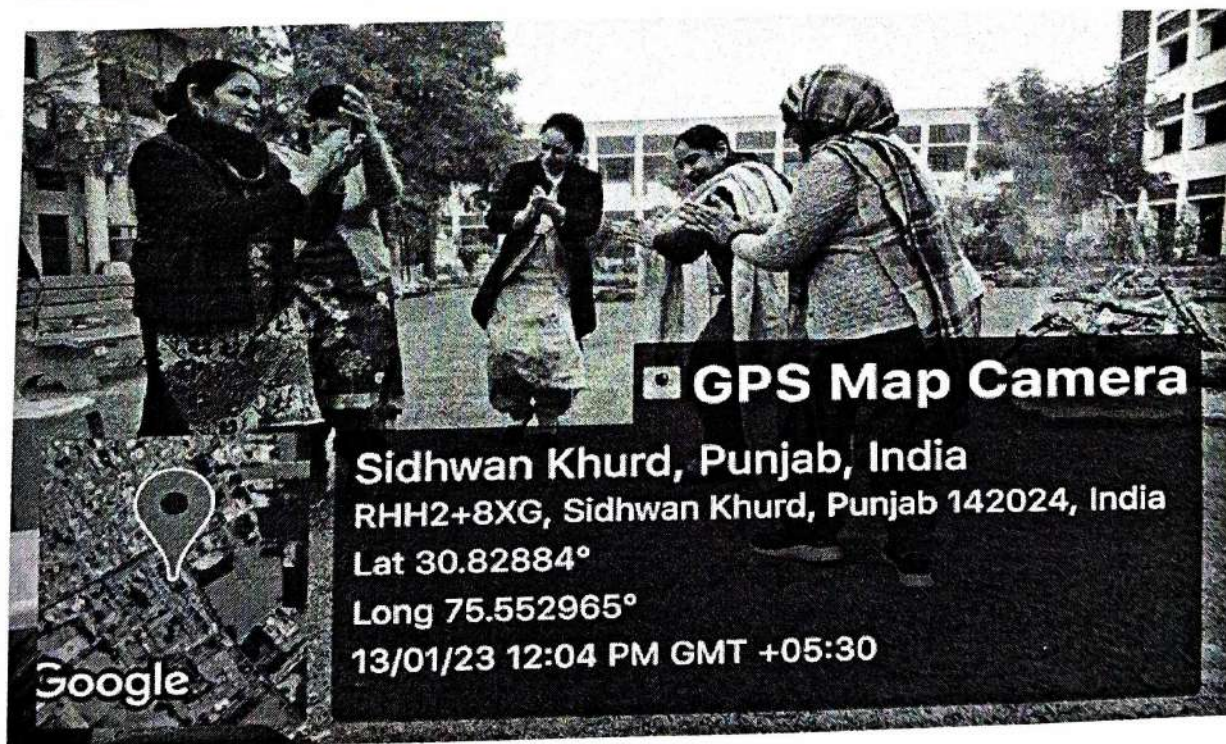
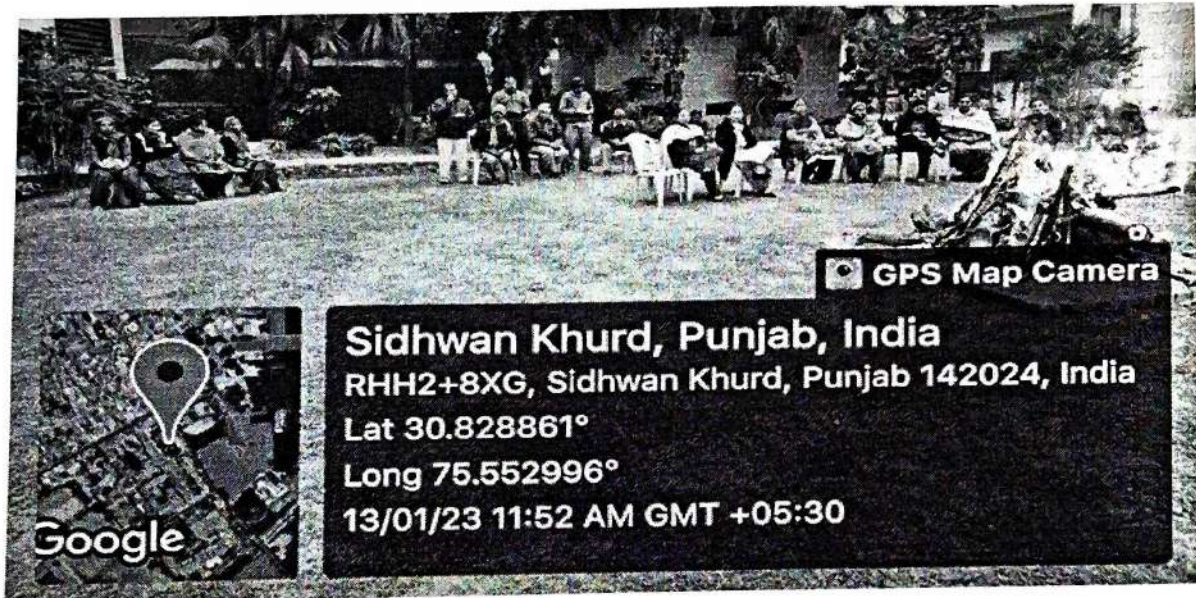

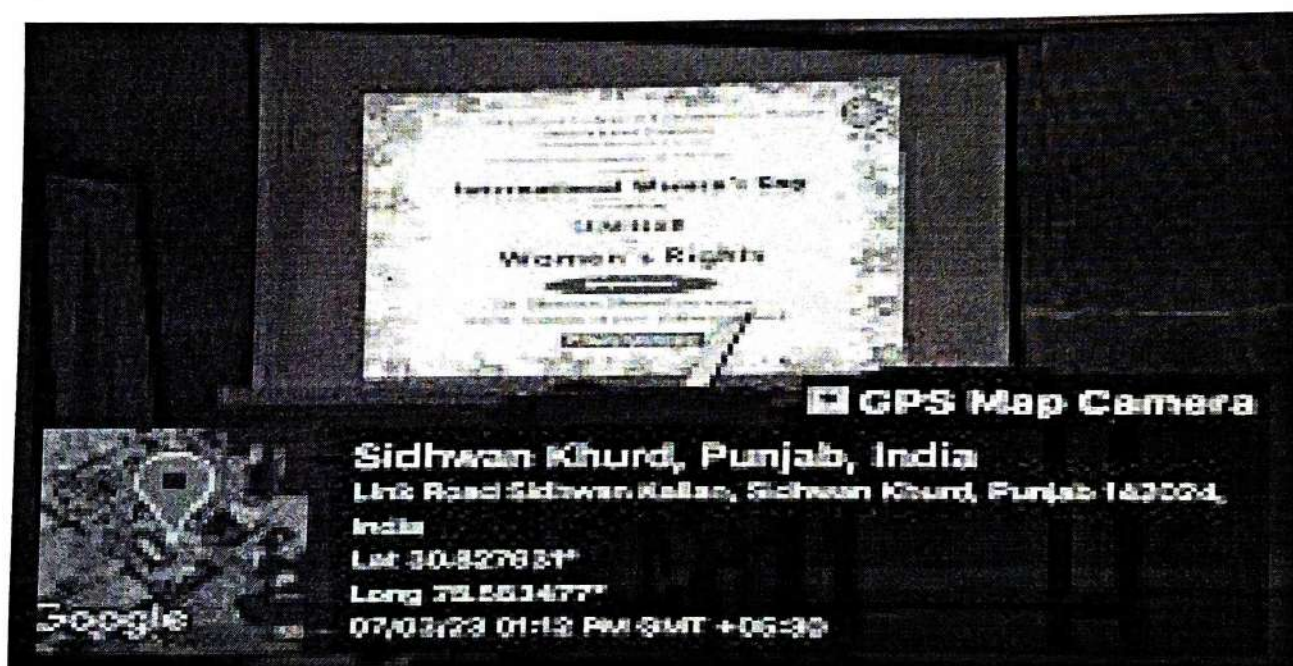
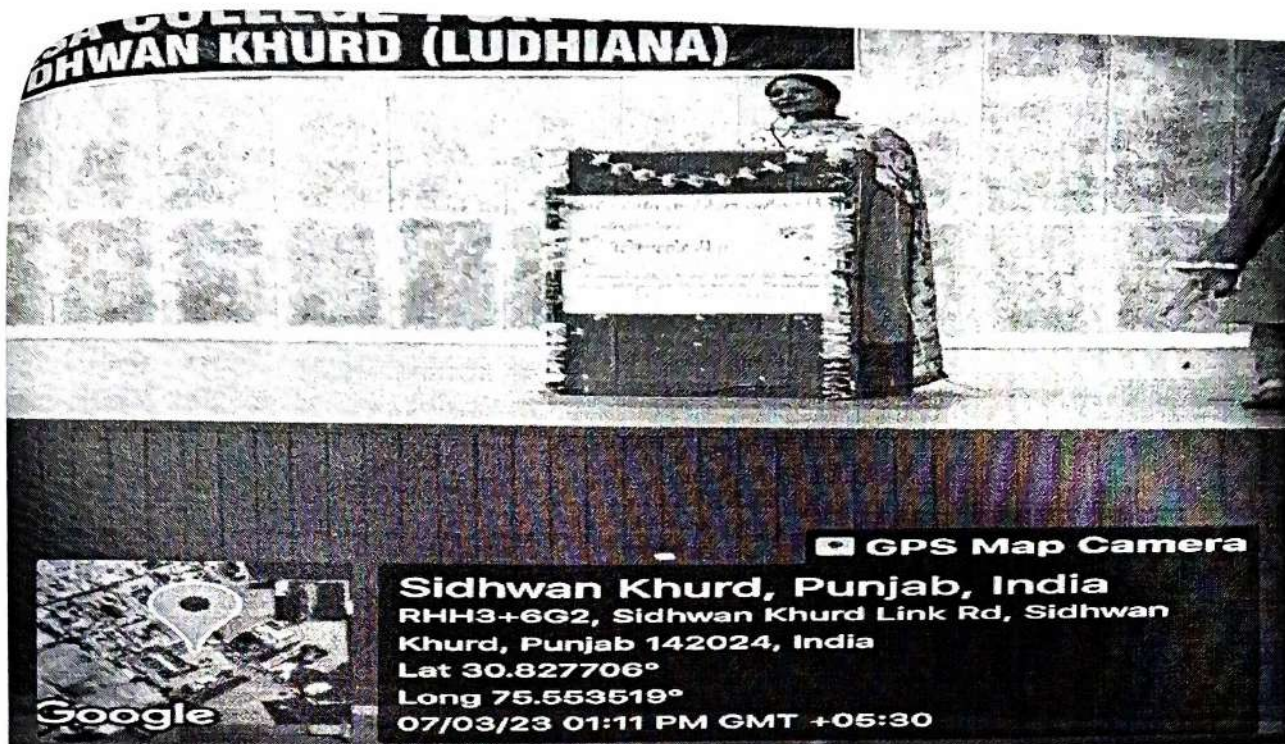




### **International Women day (7<sup>th</sup> March, 2023)**

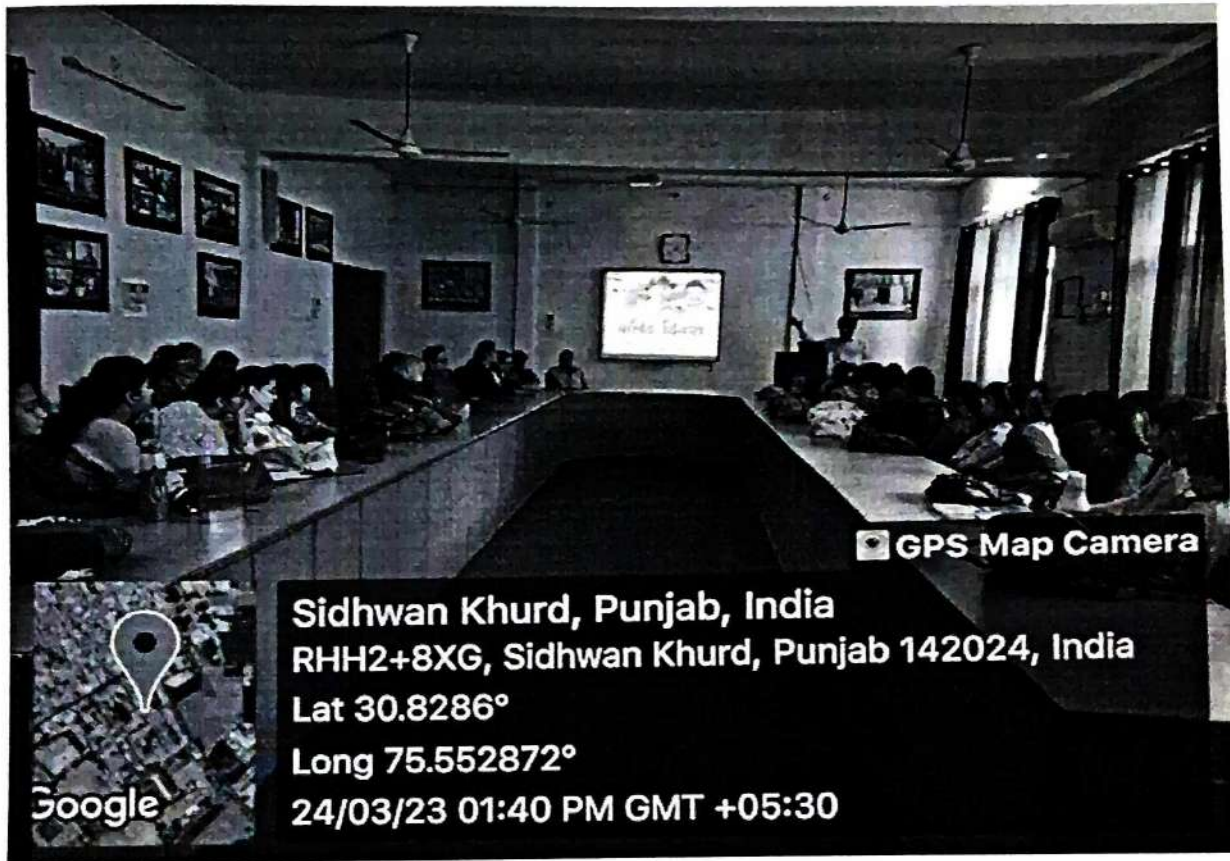


### Shaheed Bhagat Singh Martyrdom Day (24<sup>th</sup> March, 2023)
