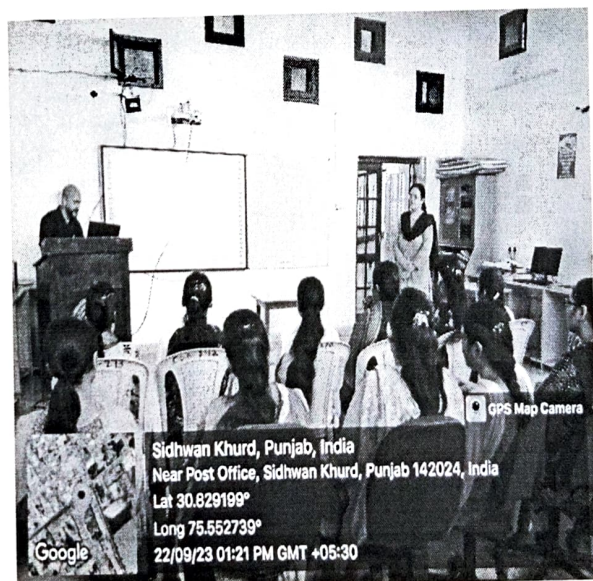
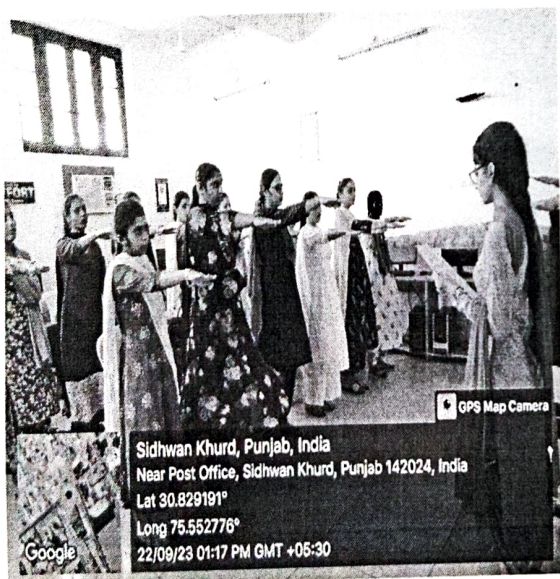


## Swachhata Hi Sewa” Campaign (15.09.23 to 02.10.23.)

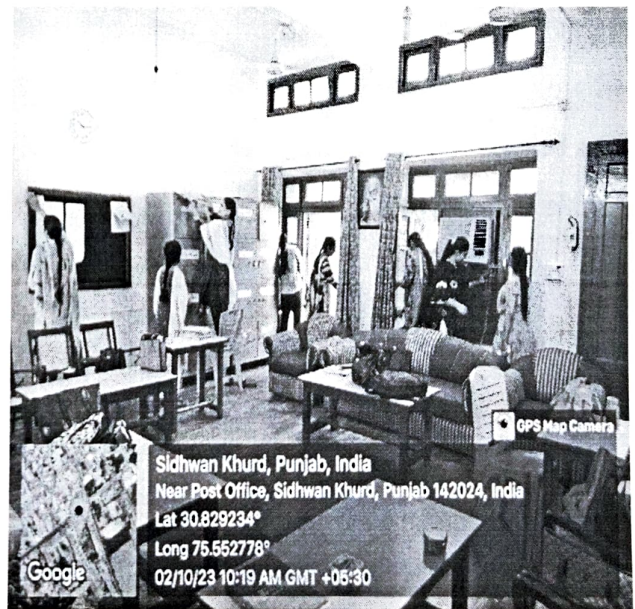
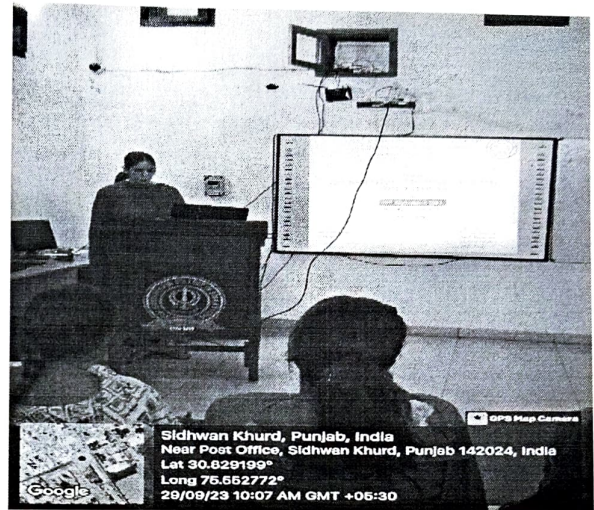
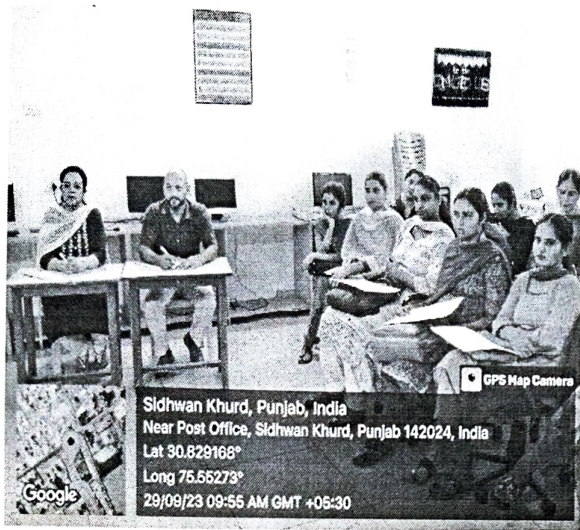

- Swachta Diwas was celebrated in the college.

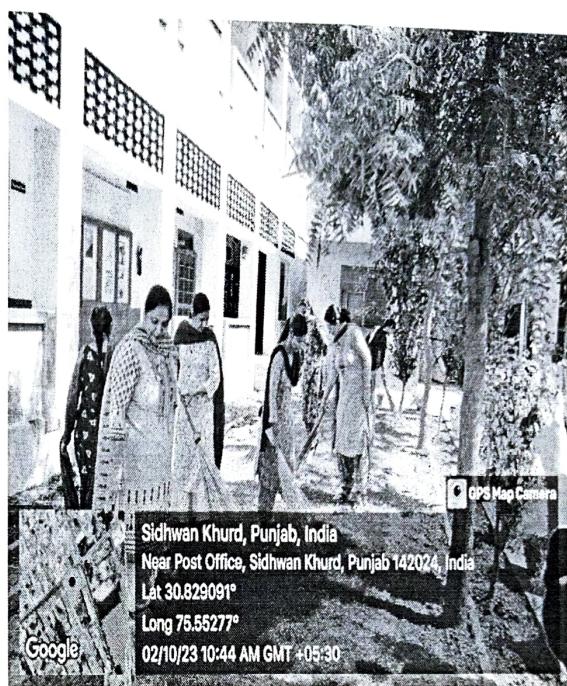

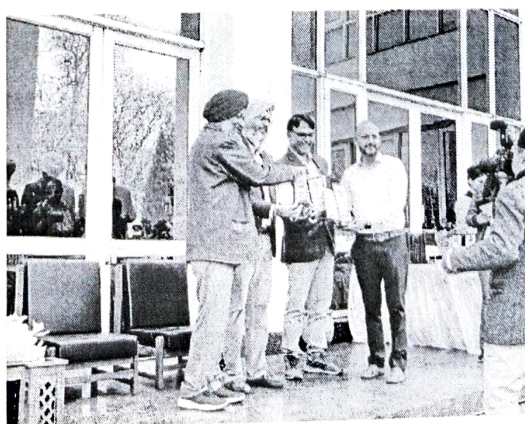
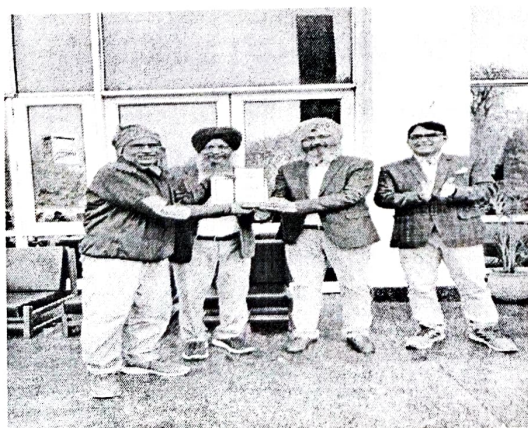




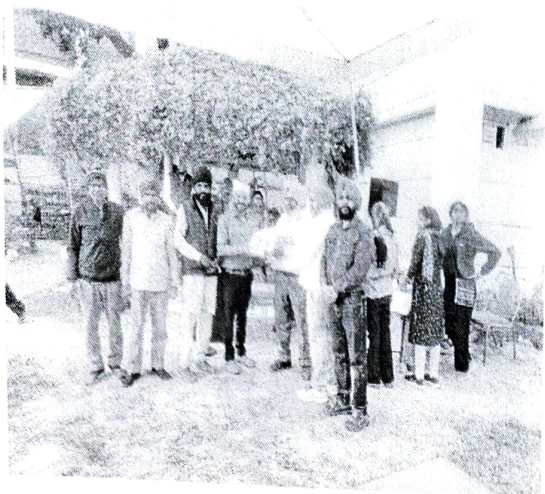


## Flower Shows (28.02.24 to 29.02.24) (09.03.24 to 10.03.24)
